
# Prepare for a Continuing Education (CE) Audit



## Continuing education is a requirement for license renewal for most architectural, engineering and construction professionals.

In order to ensure compliance and prepare for audits of employees, AEC firms should understand these requirements - which vary across the country – and have a centralized record keeping method or learning management system to track, store and report all necessary completion documents.

As your firm moves forward with learning and development plans, here are some things you should know to best prepare for a continuing education audit:

The average time U.S. engineers are required to spend annually on continuing education. States, professional organizations and government bodies all have their own rules - make sure you know which ones impact you.

### Certificates:


You must gather official CE program certificates throughout the year and submit them as proof that you or your employees have met requirements.

sign a CE completion attestation.

In both cases, record keeping proves key.






