

How Drugs & Alcohol Are Impacting Employees and Their Workplaces



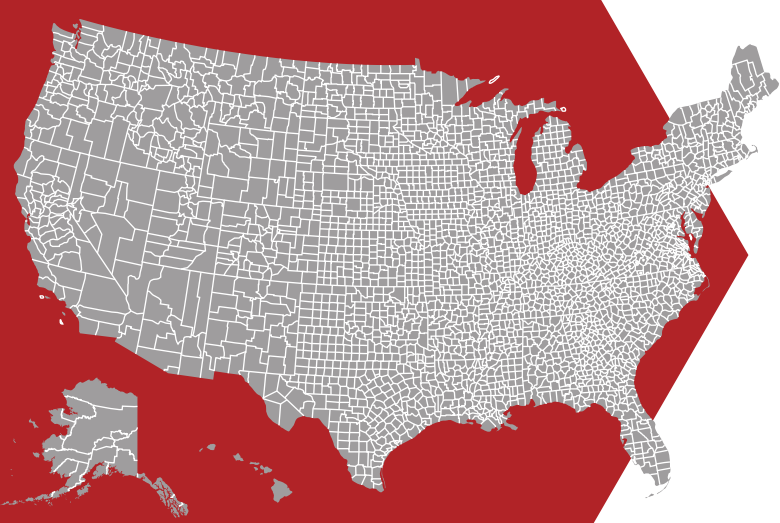

In the U.S., the number of workplace fatalities linked to unintentional drug and alcohol overdose **Jumped More Than 30% in 2016**



More than **5.3 Million American Workers** failed drug tests in 2016.



40% of U.S. Counties with manufacturing-based economies are experiencing historically high overdose rates.

An estimated **21% of construction professionals** have used illicit drugs over the past year.
