Monetary Penalties:

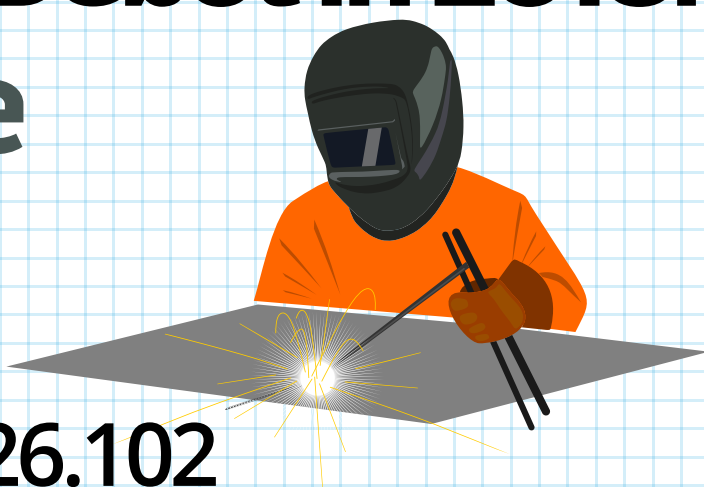
- **Serious and Other-Than-Serious:** \$12,934 per violation
- **Failure to Abate:** \$12,934 per day beyond the abatement date
- **Willful or Repeated:** \$129,336 per violation
